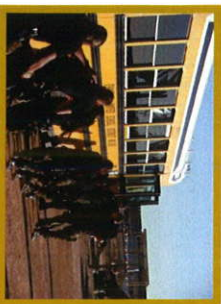

"AMERICA'S HOPE FOR THE FUTURE LIES IN THE YOUTH OF TODAY."

IN MAY OF 1959 THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FORMED THE FIRST LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPLORER POST IN THE NATION, POST # 449. THE EXPLORING PROGRAM IS A CO-EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR YOUNG ADULTS, DEVELOPED AND SUPERVISED BY LOCAL COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS WHOM PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR MEMBERS REFERRED TO AS "EXPLORERS", TO EXPLORE A CAREER IN LAW ENFORCEMENT.

EXPLORER POST # 449 IS SPONSORED BY ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF SANDRA HUTCHENS AND THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AS A COMMUNITY BASED POLICING PROGRAM. THIS SUCCESSFUL PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO EDUCATE AND INVOLVE YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN IN POLICE OPERATIONS. EXPLORERS ALSO LEARN LEADERSHIP SKILLS AND PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY.

EXPLORERS WILL BROADEN THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THE CHALLENGES THEIR COMMUNITY'S POLICE SERVICES FACE, AS WELL AS THE JOB OPPORTUNITIES OFFERED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT. IN ADDITION TO GAINING A WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF POLICE WORK, EXPLORERS HAVE NUMEROUS OPPORTUNITIES TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY SERVICE. ALTHOUGH EXPLORER POST # 449 IS LAW ENFORCEMENT ORIENTATED, EXPLORERS ARE VOLUNTEERS AND DO NOT SERVE AS POLICE EMPLOYEES, SWORN OR CIVILIAN.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

APPLICANTS MUST:

- BE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 14 1/2 AND 21 (APPLICANTS MAY BE 14 IF HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETED 8TH GRADE)
- HAVE AND MAINTAIN A MINIMUM GPA OF 2.0, AND IN GOOD STANDING WITH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS
- BE FREE OF ANY ARREST, CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS, AND NOT BE ON PROBATION
- BE FREE OF ANY SEVERE MENTAL OR PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS
