Certification of the General Municipal Election Held on November 2, 2010

Recommendation:

That the City Council:

1) Receive and file the Certificate of Results for the General Municipal Election held on November 2, 2010.

2) Adopt a Resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

Background/Discussion:

Pursuant to the City of Rancho Santa Margarita Municipal Code, on June 23, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 10-06-23-06 to call a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010 for the purpose of electing three Council Members to four-year terms. Resolution No. 10-06-23-07 was also adopted requesting the Orange County Board of Supervisors consolidate the Municipal Election with the November 2, 2010 Statewide General Election and provide election services through the Registrar of Voters Office.

On Tuesday, November 2, 2010, the General Municipal Election was conducted and the Orange County Registrar of Voters has canvassed the returns and certified the results of the election. The State Elections Code, Section 10262 (b), requires the City Council to certify the election results no later than the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the Orange County Registrar's final canvass of the returns.

Additionally, State Elections Code Section 10263 requires that upon completion of the canvass and before installing the new officers, the governing body shall adopt a resolution reciting the fact of the election and the other matters that are enumerated. The City Clerk is submitting the subject resolution for adoption as required by the State Election Code.

The official canvass of the election, which is attached to, and referenced as, "Exhibit A" of the subject resolution, contains a report of the numbers of votes cast for each candidate.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact.

Conclusion:

As required by the State's Elections Code, staff is requesting the City Council:

- 1) Receive and file the Certificate of Results for the General Municipal Election held on November 2, 2010.
- 2) Adopt a Resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Rancho Santa Margarita, California, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 00-21 adopted August 3, 2000, authorizing consolidation with the County, the Orange County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The whole number of ballots cast in the precincts, except vote by mail ballots and provisional ballots was 7,497;

That the whole number of vote by mail ballots cast in the City was 8,191, the whole number of provisional ballots cast in the City was 826, making the total number of ballots cast in the City was 16,514.

SECTION 2. The names of persons voted for at the Election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

Gary Thompson
Neil C. Blais
Steven Baric
Jesse Petrilla
Lawrence "Larry" McCook

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that: Jesse Petrilla was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Steven Baric was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; and Gary Thompson was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The total number of votes given at each precinct to each person; 5) the total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; That the City Clerk (or designee) shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
