Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)


- Comprehensive Outline

- Aligns with OC Fire and Sheriff's protocols
- National Incident Management System (NIMS)
- Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS)
- Ensures FEMA compliance and reimbursement
- No Mandated Update Timeframe




Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)

Local Government Requirements:

- Local governments (cities, counties, school districts, and special districts) are required to use SEMS and NIMS when responding to, managing, and recovering from disasters or major emergencies, including developing and maintaining EOPs.


















Airport Fire

RFP Process

- RFP issued Jan 13, 2025
- 7 proposals received
- Posted on City and OC APA websites
- Reviewed by Planning, Engineering & Public Works, PIO, Emergency Management
- Firms ranked; Top 2 interviewed

Scope of Work
