His belief in creating gathering places, such as Lago Santa Margarita, became one of his favorite spots in the City. He lovingly referred to it as his "serenity circle."

Richard Reese leaves behind a legacy of a thriving community where his influence resonates in its residents' laughter, conversations, and shared moments.


