**ORANGE COUNTY ISSUES EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION  
IN RESPONSE TO THE AIRPORT FIRE**

On September 10, 2024, the County of Orange proclaimed a local emergency in response to the Airport Fire. Orange County Fire Authority Assistant Chief Rob Capobianco, the Director of Emergency Services, requested that the Orange County Board of Supervisors proclaim a local emergency. The local emergency proclamation was approved.

This emergency proclamation allows the County to fully deploy all available resources, actions, and measures deemed necessary to ensure the safety and welfare of Orange County residents and property. Assistance from other local agencies in Southern California area is supplementing local resources.
