

HOME GENERATED SHARPS DISPOSAL

It is illegal to dispose of hypodermic needles, pen needles, intravenous needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate the skin for the delivery of medications in your CR&R carts. California Health and Safety Code requires that all sharps waste be disposed of in an approved collection container. Discarded needles may expose waste workers to potential needle stick injuries and risk of infection.

RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA RESIDENTS HAVE THE FOLLOWING TWO OPTIONS: SHARPS/USED NEEDLE COLLECTION PROGRAM

1. Visit the City of Rancho Santa Margarita, City Hall, to pick up a **FREE** Sharps Disposal by Mail kit. The system is comprised of a container in which you place your used needles and a government approved return by mail system and instructions for use. When the container is full, it is mailed in the pre-paid postage return box. The waste will then be properly documented and destroyed.

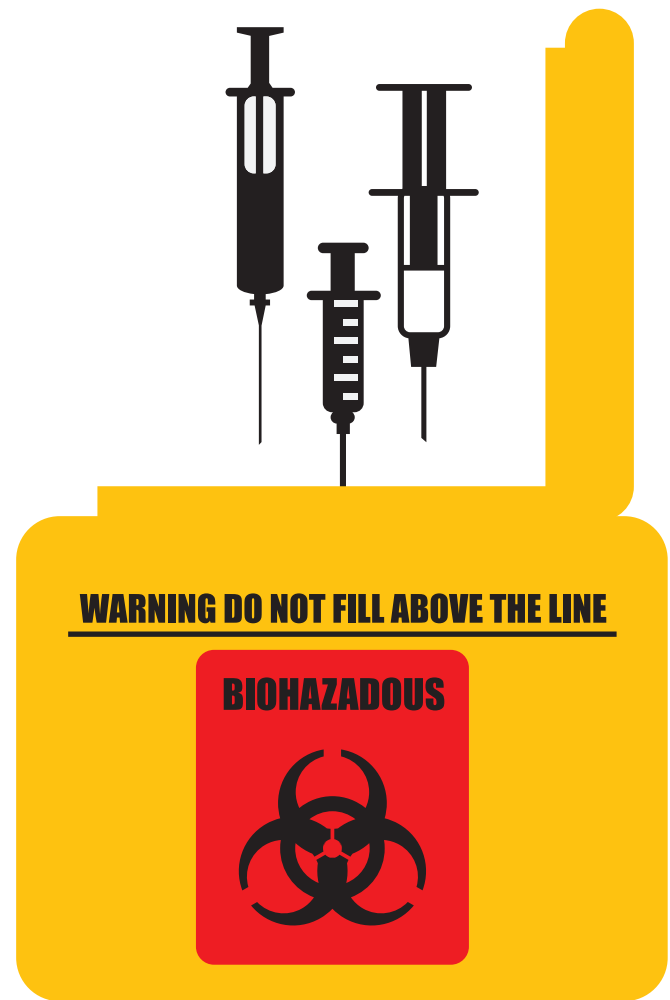
