

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA, CALIFORNIA,
ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR CITY
COUNCILMEMBERS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In accordance with Government Code Section 36516 each Member of the City Council shall be entitled to a salary in the amount of \$400.00 per month. Such compensation shall be payable in the same manner as salaries are paid to other officers and employees of the City.

Section 2: In accordance with Government Code Section 36514.5 and upon submission of an itemized account, any Council Member may be reimbursed for the actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of official duties.

Section 3: The City Council determines that this Ordinance is necessary for the proper establishment of a functioning city.

Section 4: California Government Code Section 57376 requires this Ordinance upon incorporation of a new city. This Urgency Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Government Code Section 36937 for the immediate protection of the public health, welfare, and general safety in that the residents of Rancho Santa Margarita will need and require the benefit of all health and safety laws of the County of Orange effective from January 1, 2000.

Section 5: The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be posted as required by law.




